VILLAGE OF NEW WINDSOR ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES / GOLF CART PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

It will be a violation of the Village of New Windsor Regulations to operate an off-road motor vehicle or golf cart under any of the following conditions:

- 1. At a rate of speed that is unreasonable or above posted speed limit.
- 2. While under the influence of intoxicating liquor, controlled substance or drugs.
- 3. In a manner that creates loud unnecessary or unusual noise disturbs or interferes with the peace and quiet of other persons.
- 4. On the private property of another without express written permission of the owner or lessee of the property.
- 5. On public property, including, but not limited to, school grounds, park property, playgrounds, recreation areas and golf courses, without express provisions or permission to do so by the proper public authority.
- 6. No off-road motor vehicle shall be operated within the right of way of any public street unless the vehicle complies with state and village regulations and the operator possess a valid state driver's license.
 - 7. Off-road motor vehicles will only cross Highway 17 from 1st Avenue thru 7th Avenue.
- 8. A person must not cause or allow the emission of sound from any property-line that exceeds the limits set forth in this regulation. Sound pressure levels must be measured at least 25 feet from the property-line noise source. From the hours of 8am to 8pm no residential or commercial property owner shall omit more than 75 Octave Band Sound Pressure Levels (dB) that travels 25 feet beyond their property line. From the hours of 8pm to 8am no residential or commercial property owner shall omit more than 35 Octave Band Sound Pressure Levels (dB) that travels 25 feet beyond their property line. Many Cell Phones allow the user to download an application that will measure the Octave Band Sound Pressure Levels (dB).
- 9. Every vehicle requesting a village permit must display a slow-moving vehicle emblem mounted on the rear of the vehicle. It consists of a fluorescent yellow-orange triangle with a dark red reflective border. The yellow-orange, fluorescent triangle is a highly visible color for daylight exposure. The reflective border defines the shape of the fluorescent color in daylight and creates a hollow red triangle in the path of motor vehicle headlights at night. The color film pattern, its dimensions or the backing, must not be altered to permit the use of advertising or other markings.
- 10. Possessing a Village of New Windsor ATV/Golf cart is a privilege and not a right. The permit may be voided if the driver of the vehicle is found to violate have violated the rules set forth on this form regardless of ownership.
